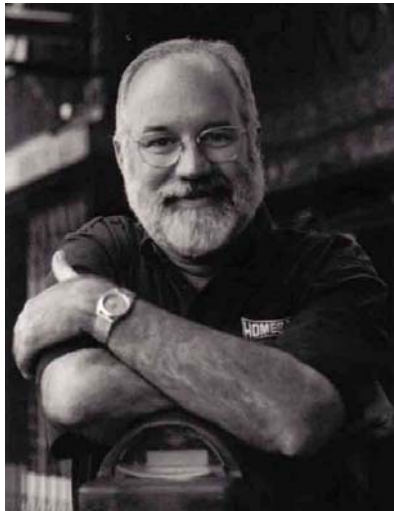
## Sacramento Entertainment Books

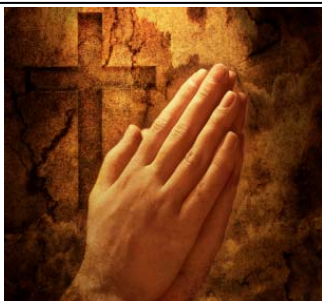
